GRADUATE ADMISSIONS STATISTICS

The data in this document pertains to individuals who submitted an application for admission to graduate programmes starting in the academic year 2022–23.


The University of Oxford's graduate programmes can be generally categorised as research or taught. Research programme participants, typically pursuing a DPhil, undertake research supervised by an academic mentor with whom they have regular meetings. Supervisors offer guidance on the specific project, research nature, data collection methods, and expected standards. As part of their research degree, students often take courses on specialised research skills, attend seminars, and lectures.

Taught programmes, usually at the master's level, typically involve core and optional courses, culminating in a dissertation. Assessment methods may include coursework, examinations, and a dissertation. Seminars and lectures support the study process.

Offer figures encompass all conditional or unconditional offers extended by academic departments or faculties.

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Departments and faculties are grouped into four academic divisions and the Department for Continuing Education. Acceptance figures indicate the number of candidates who have fulfilled all conditions and are set to enrol. All graduate students, except those on non-matriculated courses, belong to both a department or faculty and a college or hall. Candidates could apply for more than one graduate programme per year, leading to a higher number of applications than the individuals applying in any given year.



11,413 applications (30.4%) were for **graduate research degrees**

26,180 applications (69.6%) were for **graduate taught degrees**

28,019 applications (74.5%) were received from candidates with a country of domicile outside of the UK

3,767 (10.0%) were domiciled in EU countries

24,252 (64.5%) were domiciled in non-EU countries

9,574 (25.5%) were domiciled in the United Kingdom








WORLDWIDE DISTRIBUTION OF APPLICATIONS


Figure 2a. Applications, offers and acceptances by domicile type








Figure 3. Applications, offers and acceptances by sex, division and programme type


