New Student Tuition Fee Rates 2009/10 - Undergraduate

These are the tuition fee rates for new students beginning their programme of study (course) in academic year 2009/10. Tuition fees do not include college fees, accommodation, or other course and maintenance fees.

The rates listed are for one academic year, 2009/10. You should expect to pay tuition fees for every year you are in attendance and be aware these fees will increase annually.
