AWARDS

The Vice-Chancellors' Fund has been established through donations by members of the Chancellor's Court of Benefactors in honour of three recent Vice-Chancellors, Lord Neill of Bladen, Sir Richard Southwood and Sir Peter North. The Fund is intended to assist students in the final stages of their DPhil. Awards vary and do not exceed £3,000, and will be calculated on a pro rata basis for part time students.

ELIGIBILITY

- Students should be planning to submit their thesis between 1 September 2017 and 31 March 2018;
- Students must have applied for Confirmation of Status by 31 January 2017 and this must be achieved by 30 April 2017;
- Students must be able to demonstrate that they are in need of financial assistance;
- Students must be able to demonstrate that they are academically outstanding;
- Students should not be beyond their fourth year of study at the time of application.

- The student should complete Part A of the application form. All information must be included on the application form using the space provided. Enclosures will not be accepted and will not be taken into consideration by the Committee. Please do not expand sections.

- Part C should be given to your College Hardship Officer to complete. This section is available
