

Oxford-Prague Bursary 2016/17



OVERVIEW

The Europaeum gives a small bursary to support a University of Oxford graduate student to pursue a programme of study at Charles University, Prague, during the forthcoming academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Nationality:	All
Fee status:	Home/EU and Overseas
Level of study:	Graduates, all years
Subject:	Open to students from the Social Sciences and Humanities division. Appropriate programmes of study can include periods of specialist library or archive work, supervisions with desired tutors, taught programmes including specialist summer schools, or fieldwork, including work with organisations based in and around Prague. Research and study themes should normally be on themes that reflect the concerns, past, present and future, of Europe.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Application documents:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Europaeum application form• CV (max. 2 pages)• Budget breakdown• Details of any contact applicant has already had with Charles University, Prague• Letter of support from supervisor
Closing date:	Application documents should be submitted to Student Fees and Funding by 12 noon on Wednesday 1 February 2017.
Results:	The selection process is carried out by the Europaeum and students will be informed after they have made their decision (usually in January).

OTHER INFORMATION

Successful candidates are expected to be self-directed, and will need to negotiate their own study arrangements.

Students will be responsible for their own accommodation in Prague.
