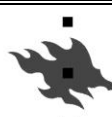

Oxford-Geneva Study Bursary 2016-2017

The Europaeum is once again making a stipend available to support an Oxford graduate student to undertake a period of research study at the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies Geneva, during the coming academic year.

The ***Oxford-Geneva Bursary Scheme*** will award one graduate €1,000 to spend at least three weeks doing research integral to their degree studies in Geneva. The scheme, which is now in its sixteenth year, has always proved popular. The grant is intended to ensure graduates can cover travel, accommodation and other related costs during their study period. Study can include periods of specialist library or archive work; supervisions with desired tutors; taught programmes, or field work, including work with organisations based in and around Geneva.

Bursary holders are expected to be self-directed, and will need to negotiate their own study arrangements.
