Oxford-Prague Study Bursary 2016-2017

The Europaeum is pleased to announce the introduction of a new study bursary scheme that will link Charles University, Prague and the University of Oxford. The ***Oxford-Prague Study Bursary Scheme***, supported by Sekyra Group, will provide two graduate students with an award of €1000 each to spend a month doing research integral to their degree studies. The scheme will allow one Charles graduate to undertake a period of research study in Oxford, and an Oxford graduate student to spend a month attached to Charles University. The award is modelled on our highly successful *Oxford-Geneva Bursary Scheme* and is intended to ensure graduates can cover travel, accommodation and other related costs during their study period.

Students are expected to be self-directed and to manage their own study visit. Study can include periods of specialist library or archive work; supervisions with desired tutors; taught programmes, or fieldwork.
