Student Self Service access between 19 December 2014 to 6 January 2015

Student Self Service is being upgraded. You will be unable to access the system from 18:00 Friday 19 December until 08:30 Monday 22 December. From Monday 22 December to Tuesday 6 January, Student Self Service will be available for you to view your details and results, print an enrolment certificate and access the admissions code, if applicable. You will not be able to update any details. (A second period of system unavailability is provisionally scheduled between Saturday 27 December to Monday 29 December). Student Self Service will re-open with update access, to include University registration for Hilary term students, from 09:00 Tuesday 6 January. A reminder will be emailed to those students who need to register at this time.

The Examination Schools submission desk will close for Christmas and the New Year at 17:00 on Tuesday, 23 December 2014 and will reopen at 08:30 on Monday, 5 January 2014.

If you are a Postgraduate Taught student due to complete your course in the current academic year, you will have received an invite to book your degree ceremony. You may amend your choice of booking date up to 17:00, Friday 19 December. The degree booking system will then be unavailable until 09:00 on Tuesday 6 January 2015. You may log back in to amend your choice of booking date between Tuesday 6 - Friday 31 January 2015, after which time you will be able to amend only your accessibility and college catering requirements.
