



Santander Academic Travel Awards 2017

Are you a postgraduate student? Are you conducting fieldwork in Argentina, Belgium, Brazil, Chile, China, Colombia, Germany, Ghana, Korea, Mexico, Peru, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Russia, Singapore, Spain, United Arab Emirates, Uruguay and USA? Are you visiting a university or giving a conference paper in one of these countries?

If your answer is “Yes”, then you can apply for a Santander Academic Travel Award.

What are the Santander Academic Travel Awards?

These awards enable postgraduate students at the University of Oxford – of any nationality – to travel to Santander Network countries for academic-related activities, including visits to Santander universities to do collaborative work, to conduct fieldwork, to give a paper at a conference, or to engage in other academic related activity. The awards are open to postgraduates working in any subject. The maximum value of each award is £1,000.

Application materials:

- International Opportunities online application form
- CV including a list of publications (if any), prizes, and academic history (full details of school and university education), along with a statement of your extra-curricular activities and interests
- Budget breakdown showing proposed costs for period of travel abroad. Please include details of any travel and maintenance costs (including accommodation and subsistence).
- Name and contact details of one referee. Your referee will be contacted automatically by email and asked to submit a reference as soon as you submit your application. Therefore please ensure you seek their approval to be nominated as a referee in advance. It is your responsibility to ensure that your referee submits their reference by the deadline.

Students can only receive one award per year.

Applications for travel between 1 April 2017 and 31 December 2017 must be submitted by **12 noon on Friday 3 February 2017**.

Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted under any circumstances.
