Graduate Studies: Research programmes

The fee rates quoted in the table below are University composition fees only. In addition, College fees are payable. Information about College fee rates may be obtained by contacting your College Office.

The definitions used by the University in the **classification of students for fee purposes** as 'Home/EU' or 'Overseas' are given in the Prospectus and the University's Examination Regulations. This classification depends on certain residence conditions, and students in doubt about their classification should contact their College Office or the University Fees Clerk (telephone: 01865 270203). Research students from the Channel Islands and Isle of Man are liable for tuition fees at the Home/EU rate.

Unless otherwise stated, rates listed below are for full-time study. For subjects offered by part-time study, where no part-time rate is quoted below, fees for part-time students are half the full-time rate.

The University is in the process of phasing in changes in overseas fee category for certain programmes of study. The tables below list research subject areas according fee category and phasing of category changes. The relevant start date for determining an overseas student's fee category is the date they commence DPhil study, except in the case of students progressing from Oxford graduate taught programme to DPhil in the same subject area without a break in study, where the student's start date on the graduate taught programme applies.
