## University Composition Fees 2007-08

### Undergraduate programmes

The fee rates quoted in the table below are University composition fees only. Separate **College fees** are payable by all students *except* Home/EU students taking their first publicly-funded course of Higher Education and eligible in principle to apply for public support for tuition.

The definitions used by the University in the **classification of students for fee purposes** as 'Home/EU', 'Islands' (Channel Islands and Isle of Man) or 'Overseas' are given in the Undergraduate Prospectus and the University's Examination Regulations. This classification depends on certain residence conditions, and students in doubt about their classification should contact their College Office or the University Fees Clerk (telephone: 01865 270040, e-mail fees.clerk@admin.ox.ac.uk).

The University is in the process of phasing in several changes in fee regulations. Fee rates for Home/EU students vary according to whether a student was either (i) admitted up to and including 2005/6 (including those who applied during the 2004 admissions cycle for deferred entry in 2006/7), or (ii) admitted in or after 2006/07, in which case the student is liable for the higher variable fee under the provisions of the Higher Education Act 2004. Overseas fee category changes are also being introduced for certain programmes of study, for which the fee rate applicable is dependant on the date on which the overseas student commenced their current programme of undergraduate study.

Students working for a degree requiring study abroad for a whole academic year, where the period of residence in Oxford during the year abroad is ten weeks or less, pay a reduced **fee for the year abroad**: £610 for those admitted in 2005/06 and before, £1,535 for those admitted from 2006/07. This fee is payable whether the student is working or studying abroad.

+ Notes. 'Admitted' date refers to date of admission to Pre-clinical course. Graduate entry course comprises one year of Pre-clinical Medicine (fee charged at Pre-clinical rate) and three years of Clinical Medicine (fee charged at Clinical rate).
