Number of undergraduates: 260

Location:

Mansfield occupies one of the best sites in Oxford, a short walk away from the Science Area and University libraries and close to the city centre, but in a quiet position near the University Parks.

Accommodation:

All undergraduate students are housed in Mansfield accommodation. Most students, including all first years, live on the main college site, with the rest in college accommodation a 15-minute walk away. The majority of rooms on the main site are ensuite and all have access to kitchens for student use. For 2021-22 rent and utilities will be £1600 per term for all undergraduate rooms. Laundry use is included in this, and kettles and fridges are provided in all mainsite rooms.

Accessibility: The College buildings are located around one large Quad. There are step-free routes from the main entrance to all buildings. The Dining Hall, Crypt Cafe and Junior Common Room have step-free access, as do many of the seminar and teaching rooms. There are four accessible public toilets throughout the College buildings. There are two fully accessible student bedrooms. There are also 24 ground floor rooms, and lifts in the Garden Building and Hands Building accommodation.

The main library does not have step-free access, but the Librarians offer a delivery service and there are several step-free study spaces available.

We encourage prospective students to contact the College in confidence to discuss specific needs. Please email the Registrar and Director of Admissions (registrar@mansfield.ox.ac.uk) who can advise on access to college facilities, accommodation, and other provision.

Information about catering: Our food is considered some of the best in Oxford. There is plenty of choice at meals, including vegetarian, vegan and halal options. Our kitchen staff can cater for a variety of dietary requirements, including gluten/dairy free and allergies. We've been voted the best Oxford college for vegetarian and vegan food in Oxford twice in a row. Students also have access to several large kitchens in both onsite and off-site accommodation. There is a separate kitchen for students who keep Kosher. Meals are charged to your student billing account, which is paid twice a term. Students living on the main college site eat a minimum of forty meals per term. Lunch and dinner are £3.50 each. There is no breakfast provision. Formal halls are usually twice a week (Wednesdays and Fridays) and Formal Formal Hall (a slightly fancier version of formal hall!) takes place three times a term.

College societies: We may be small, but there is always lots going on. We have lots of sports and societies within the college. Film society, drama, poetry, tennis, netball, rowing, football, ultimate frisbee, Love Island Society and even a new Euro 2020 fantasy league to name a few. Mansfield also has a non-auditioned choir, open to anyone who can read music.
