Returning Student Tuition Fee Rates 2009/10 - Undergraduate

These are the tuition fee rates for students who began their programme of study (course) during the academic year 2008/09 or before. Tuition fees do not include college fees, accommodation, or other course and maintenance fees.

The rates listed are for one academic year, 2009/10. You should expect to pay tuition fees for every year you are in attendance and be aware these fees will increase annually. Fee rates are split into three residency categories: Home/EU, Islands* and Overseas. For further information about your classification please see the website.

The University is in the process of phasing in several changes in fee regulations. This means for some programmes of study (courses) the fee rate applicable is dependent on the date on which you commenced your current programme of study.

Understanding the tuition fee rate tables

You can identify which fee applies to you on the fee rate tables by first locating your programme of study and then your fee status (Home/EU, Islands, Overseas) and finally the year in which you started. For example using the table below an Overseas, BA Ancient and Modern History student who began their course in 2004/05 will pay a fee of £10,100 whereas a student on the same course who began their studies in 2005/06 will pay a fee of £11,750 (example based on 2009/10 fee rates)
