Number of undergraduates:

Around 475 undergraduates, of which 435 live onsite.
The largest undergraduate College at Oxford.

Location

Surrounded on three sides by parks, green space and the River Cherwell yet still only 10 minutes' walk into the heart of Oxford, Catz has the best of both worlds.

Accommodation:

All rooms cost the same (approx. £155/week for 30 weeks). 1st and 3rd years mostly live in 'Old Quad', with shared bathroom and kitchen facilities. 2nd years mostly live in 'New Quad', all with ensuite bathrooms. All rooms are bright and airy with views of the quads, meadows or river. Accessible rooms are also available.

Accessibility:

Most College facilities are on the ground floor and are wheelchair accessible. We have accessible ground floor rooms and accessible bathrooms available to students.

Information about catering:

Catz has the largest Dining Hall of any Oxford College. 3 meals a day would cost around £9-10 with most dietary requirements catered for. Meals are provided on a pay-as-you-eat basis.

Breakfast: Cooked and continental breakfast served 6 days a week, 4 items £1.33, 8 items £2.66 inc. tea/coffee/juice.

Dinner: 'Scaf': dinner through the servery at 6pm on weeknights and Saturdays. £2-5 per meal.

Served Hall: 7pm every weeknight in term time with no formal dress code. £4.32 for 3 courses, tea and coffee.

Different themed nights each week and barbecues on the Quad in Summer.

Formal/black tie: 1 or 2 times a term. All accommodation have kitchenettes for students to self-cater.

College societies:

A large and diverse student body means Catz has over 50 clubs and societies to suit all tastes. From Music Society to Gardening Club, there's something for everyone. If a society doesn't exist, funding is available for you to start your own.

Other College facilities:

Gym: 24/7 onsite gym and squash courts - £3 induction then free for the duration of your degree. Comprehensive weights area as well as a variety of cardio equipment.

Music: our Music House can be booked by the hour for free: rehearsals, band practice etc.

Library: the library is open 8/9am - midnight every day. Bright, airy and spacious - one of the largest of any Oxford college with over 60,000 books!

Sports facilities: Catz has an array of college sport teams for all ability levels. A large and diverse student body means Catz usually does quite well in sports. Our playing fields are a short walk from the College, which include Tennis courts. Catz also has a boathouse on the River Thames.

Welfare: We have an onsite Counsellor available for free for students, as well a College Nurse. Peer supporters and Junior Deans are also on hand to support our students' welfare.
