**Number of undergraduates:** About 450; we're one of the largest colleges.

**Location:** Located a short bike ride from the centre of Oxford and offering students peaceful and expansive gardens, St Hugh's is very close to the Maths Department, The Radcliffe Humanities buildings, and the Science Site. We've also got University Parks and Port Meadow - two of the biggest green spaces in Oxford - on our doorstep.

**Accommodation:** Accommodation is offered for all years of an undergraduate's course and is all located on our main site. A range of rooms are available, many of which are en suite. Prices: cost per term 2020/21 £1,452 or £4,356 per year. Democratic room ballot after first year.

**Accessibility:** Comprehensive College-organised support: on-site Nurse and Wellbeing Coordinator (who also organises lots of wellbeing events), Disability Officer, College Counsellor, and Chaplain. 24/7 emergency support is available through Lodge and Junior Deans. We also have a well-developed peer support system and many informal types of support (college families, Principal's events, welfare animals, etc.). The College has many accessible rooms and facilities, and is very happy to adapt accommodation to individual requirements.

## **Information about catering**

Three meals a day in hall during the week and brunch at weekends - a flexible pay as you go, cashless system.

All accommodation has access to kitchens, so students can cook whenever they want.

Hall prices: each item is costed separately so it depends on what you like eating! A meal can cost anything between £1.50 and £4.50.

We cater to all types of dietary requirements; vegan and vegetarian options are on offer alongside meat/fish options as standard (we also have Meat Free Mondays). Gluten-free, Hahal, Kosher meals are also available upon request - just let us know what you require!

Formal halls take place weekly.

We also have a café on site which serves delicious breakfast, lunch, snacks and coffee on weekdays during term time at very reasonable prices.
