Location:

Central location, just a short walk from shops, museums, libraries and green spaces.

Accommodation:

The College is proud to be able to provide single room accommodation for all its undergraduates. All are single rooms for single occupancy and cannot be shared. Rooms are allocated by the Accommodation Office to all undergraduates in their first year.

The majority of rooms have access to shared bathrooms but a number of rooms are en-suite. The charges for accommodation for the academic year 2020-21 will be between £16.59- £19.51 per day.

Accessibility:

A significant proportion of our buildings are wheelchair accessible, we are working to adapt those which are currently not. Many of the new buildings have hearing loops, ramps and lifts. There are accessible toilets throughout college and accessible/ adapted bedrooms.







Information about catering:

All Meals now include vegan and vegetarian selection as well as a standard meal. All special diets are catered for formal hall is four times a week plus special occasions and Sunday Brunch is very popular with the students starts at 10 to 12.30pm.

Average cost:

Continental Breakfast - £1.15, Brunch dish of the day £1.80 Cooked breakfast is charged pre item - £2.50 bacon, sausage, egg, hash brown and beans. Lunch is a fixed £2.92 two course hot meal and pudding or the option of fruit. Informal dinner fixed £4.09 (2 course).

Formal 3 course fixed £ 4.39.

Selection of soft drinks £1.50.

Halal meat is identified on the weekly menu, there is at least one dish suitable for Halal diet.
