Starting a new year

Thank you for signing up again to receive the Teachers' Newsletter; we're delighted that you're interested in finding out more about Oxford University.

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Dates and deadlines



Outcomes

As you no doubt know, all shortlisted applicants for entry in 2018 will receive our decision on Wednesday 10 January. We hope that there will be good news for you and your students but those who are unsuccessful should know that last October we received over 22,000 applications for around 3,250 places.

Over 9,800 applicants were shortlisted for interview. Unfortunately every year there are many more brilliant applicants than places available at Oxford.

Candidates who are not offered a place may request feedback about their application - see our website for more information.

UNIQ applications are open

UNIQ is Oxford's flagship programme for raising the aspirations of students studying at UK state schools.

Students come to Oxford for a week (*UNIQ Summer*) or three days (*UNIQ Spring*), stay in a college, and attend an academic programme during the day and social activities in the evenings. They get first-hand experience of life at university, spend time with current students and gain deeper understanding of a subject that they enjoy.

This year's conferences will take place during March at venues around the country. All the details can be found on the Oxford and Cambridge Collaborative Outreach Network website.

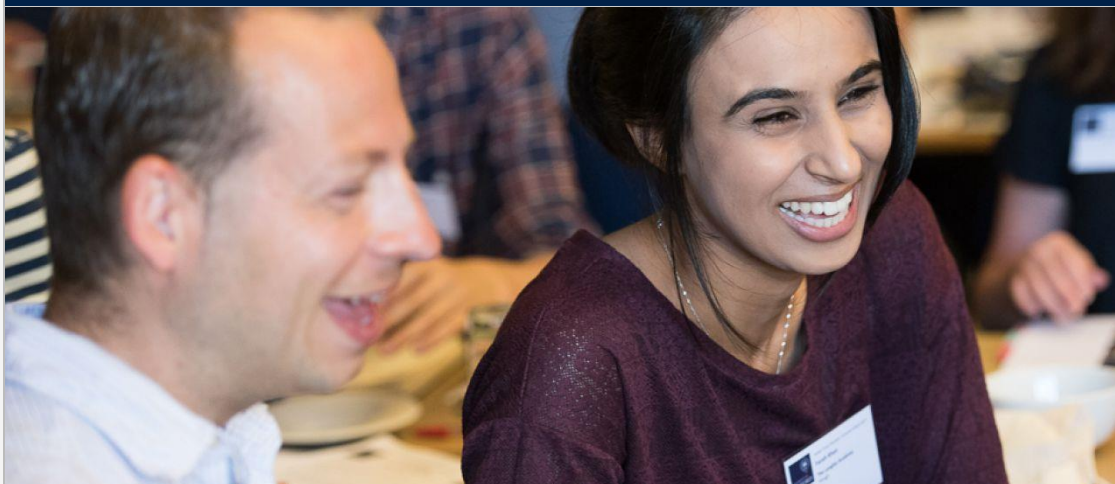
Department open days

Sutton Trust teachers' summer school

Our free Sutton Trust Teachers' Summer School is a two day residential conference on Monday 9 and Tuesday 10 July for 80 teachers from state-funded schools and colleges in the UK. We particularly welcome participants from schools with a limited history of sending students to selective universities generally and Oxford specifically.

Teachers will receive detailed support and guidance about the Oxford admissions process, experience taster sessions for different academic subjects - and have the opportunity to witness demonstration interviews.
