A unique internship

Experience the heart of politics through a parliamentary internship in the Australian Commonwealth Parliament in Canberra. Based in a Senator or MP's office, students complete a research intensive internship on current policy issues ranging from international trade, security, indigenous affairs, environment, migration, education, international relations, economic reform, cultural policy, health, development, gender and social policy.

For over two decades, this elite program has provided a foundational experience for the careers of future leaders in government, politics, NGOs and the private sector. Undergraduate and postgraduate students from any academic discipline are eligible to apply.



A world-leading university

ANIP internships are a course for credit, and include workshops on policy research and professional skills. In the workplace, student internship projects are co-supervised by academics from the Australian National University, which is ranked as Australia's leading university and 22nd globally by the QS World University Rankings 2016-17.

ANU's programs in politics and in development studies are rated in the world's top ten subjects, while economics, sociology, social policy and geography are ranked as number 1 in Australia and amongst the world's best.
