Travel information

Directions from London to Oxford...

Oxford is about 60 miles (90 kms) northwest of London and has excellent road and national rail links. Regular coach services connect Oxford with the capital and also with Heathrow and Gatwick airports.

From London airports by coach

London Heathrow and Gatwick airports are linked to Oxford by <u>The Airline</u> coach service, which operates a direct, frequent service twenty-four hours a day and arrives directly into Gloucester Green Coach Station in the city centre. Journey times are around 1.5 hours from Heathrow and 2.5 hours from Gatwick, subject to traffic conditions (please telephone +44 (0)1865 785400 for further information).

From London airports by train

London Gatwick airport is connected with London Victoria coach station by the <u>Gatwick Express</u> train, with frequent departures and a journey time of 30 minutes.

London Heathrow airport is connected with London Paddington railway station by the <u>Heathrow Express</u> train, also with frequent departures and a journey time of 15 minutes.

A direct train service operates between Oxford and London Paddington (with departures approximately every 30 minutes and a journey time of around one hour). For information, please contact National Rail Enquiries (telephone: +44 (0)8457 484950).
