3. The questions in this section are all based on an invented language, called Pub. Note also that Pub has nothing corresponding to the English the and $a(n)$, so that hohub can mean a teacher or the teacher. You are also advised to work through the questions in this section in the order in which they are given, as the later ones presuppose some information or vocabulary supplied in earlier examples.
