Some qualifications have a maximum period of University tuition fee liability. Fee rates are split into three residency categories: Home/EU, Islands* and Overseas.

If you have previously studied at graduate level (e.g. you are returning to study a second Masters degree) you may be liable to pay the higher ELQ fee given in the fee lists.
